If you find something that you would like to borrow, please write down or print the title, author and call number for that item and take it to your local library. Your public librarian can do an interlibrary loan for free. The item(s) that you have requested will be delivered to your local library for you to pick up and can be returned there to be sent back to us.

If you do not have access to a participating local school or public library, then the WESP-DHH Educational Resource Library can be contacted directly.

Please remember, however, that requests sent directly to/from the WESP-DHH Educational Resource library will be shipped by US Postal Service with reciprocal postage agreements-media mail/book rate is used to ship the items and the patron will pay postage for return.



## Guidelines



- Requests from within Wisconsin only.
- Check-out limit of three items, (books, audiovisuals, kits) per person.
- Due date is three weeks from check-out date.
- Easy Renewal is three additional weeks – just call or email your request.
- If items are lost or damaged, patron agrees to reimburse for replacement costs set by lender.
